CITY OF STEINBACH Regular Council Meeting December 17, 2024

- 1. Minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of City of Steinbach Council held on Tuesday, December 17, 2024, at City of Steinbach Council Chambers.
- 2. Mayor Earl Funk called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m., with the following members of Council present: Councillors Jake Hiebert, Susan Penner, Michael Zwaagstra, Bill Hiebert, & Jac Siemens. Also present: City Manager, Troy Warkentin, Manager, Corporate Services, Adam Thiessen, and City Clerk, Amanda Dubois.
- 3. Mayor Earl Funk opened the meeting.
- R24-243 4. Councillor J. Hiebert, Councillor M. Zwaagstra RESOLVED that the agenda be adopted as amended.

- 7. Paul Gibson (Donkey) and Lyle Koop, on behalf of the Guardians of the Children, Steinbach attended the meeting as a delegation and provided the following:
- 7.1 Guardians of the Children is not appearing before council to ask for anything, but to educate and inform the community on what they do, which is work with children who have been sexually, physically or emotionally abused and who are involved in the legal system. They symbolically adopt a family and help them in any way they need. They will provide support to the family until the child is eighteen years old.
- They are a not-for-profit, 100% volunteer organization that's sole purpose is to help a child become a victor, not a victim. Their mission is to recognize and react to child abuse and educate the public to do the same. To serve as advocates to provide strength and stability to families in crisis and to be an answer to the prayer of an abused child or teen for courage, support and protection.
- There are approximately 7800 members in approximately 85 chapters throughout North America. Each member goes through stringent criminal/vulnerable sector checks and have received child abuse awareness training.
- As well as providing support during the judicial process, Guardians of the Children maintain ongoing relationships with the child and their family. Their needs are assessed, and arrangements are made to properly address any identified issues. They actively participate in their lives, attend birthday, graduations and other key milestones, doing what it takes to make them feel safe and in empowered in their own environment.
- Mr. Gibson explained that 1 in 4 children have been abused. Individuals can be given by becoming a GOC supporter, a sponsor or a member. If there are any families in the area that need support or if they can be connected with other organizations to give support they would love to help. They are currently helping 26 families and have 16 members.
- 7. 2 Lyle Koop, a career teacher who worked within the Hanover School division for 37 years, shared his experiences working with the youth in the area, adult teen challenge and since joining Guardians of the Children. He stressed that working with affected youth early, and the ability to build them back up, gives them a better chance as adults.
- 7.3 Mr. Gibson returned to the podium to list some of the businesses they are working to partner with and encouraged everyone to help out in any way they can, by becoming a member, an advocate or a supporter.

- 8. Mayor Funk thanked Mr. Gibson and Mr. Koop for their presentation, information and for filling a much-needed gap with their organization's support.
- 9. Troy Warkentin, City Manager presented a report on the RM of Hanover proposed By-Law 2578-24.
- 9.1 Mr. Warkentin provided that in the summer of 2024, the RM of Hanover considered an application for subdivision under 4135-24-8943 to subdivide the subject property, located north of Steinbach City limits and along PTH 12 North, which the City of Steinbach provided comments and filed its objection to the proposed application. RM of Hanover Council approved the subdivision.
- 9.2 Rezoning application By-Law 2578-24 is a further proposed change to the land use policies affecting the same parcel of land. Administration feels that the previous subdivision and the proposed rezoning are both inconsistent with the provisions of the RM of Hanover Development Plan, Provincial Land Use Policies, and the joint Steinbach/Hanover Annexation Agreement, which was entered into July 21, 2015.

BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Steinbach be authorized to borrow up to \$8,000,000.00 from the Royal Bank of Canada (hereinafter referred to as "the Bank") during 2025 for operating expenses, and to pay or agree to pay interest thereon, or on so much thereof as remains from time to time paid, calculated at the Bank's prime interest rate per annum in effect from time to time minus 0.25% per annum, as well after as before maturity default and judgement, with interest on overdue interest at the same rate as the principal.

THAT the amount so borrowed with interest aforesaid be evidenced by either of the following means:

- (a) by one or more promissory notes under the seal of the corporation and signed by the Mayor and one of the following the City Manager or the Senior Manager, Finance thereof and given to the Bank; or
- (b) by overdraft on the account of the corporation with the Bank by cheques signed by the Mayor and one of the following the City Manager or the Senior Manager, Finance thereof.

THAT the Corporation hereby mortgages, assigns, transfers, pledges and hypothecates to the said Bank the taxes of the Corporation for the present year for municipal, school or the purposes of the Minister of Intergovernmental Affairs as additional security for the repayment of the amount so borrowed for any of such respective purposes.

THAT the Corporation shall deposit said taxes with the Bank as collected in a special account as collateral security for payment of the amount so borrowed and interest, but the Bank shall not be restricted to the said taxes for payment of the sum borrowed hereunder, nor shall it be bound to wait for repayment of said sum until said taxes are collected, or be required to see that they are deposited or applied as aforesaid.

THAT the amount so borrowed and interest shall be payable within the current fiscal year.

THAT the Mayor and one of the following the City Manager or the Senior Manager, Finance are hereby authorized to give to the said Bank in the name, on behalf of and under the seal of the Corporation as security for the moneys so borrowed, and interest thereon, a covenant or agreement containing a clause that all taxes levied or to be levied by the Corporation for the present year be and they are thereby pledged, hypothecated, mortgaged, transferred and assigned to the Bank as security for said loan and interest thereon and are charged as a first charge with repayment of such loan and interest, or a clause to like effect; and that said taxes shall be deposited forthwith on being collected in the Bank to the credit of the Corporation in a special account as collateral security for said advance.

Good Morning All,

Following the CMC Meeting in Edmonton on November 21, the AMM sent an inquiry to clarify the process for scheduling a meeting between Manitoba's 21 MPSA municipalities and the federal government's Chief Negotiator so he could hear your concerns and challenges first-hand before the negotiations commence. Back in June 2024, the Chief Negotiator stated that he would be willing to hold such meetings if there was interest from jurisdictions.

As you will see below, the federal government (Public Safety Canada) is now walking back this commitment, which is very disappointing.

We therefore encourage your municipalities to submit the attached template letter to assist with ongoing advocacy efforts to slow costs and enhance meaningful consultation with municipal contract partners.

Dear Minister McGuinty,

On behalf of [Municipality Name], I am writing to express concerns regarding how our municipality may be impacted by the third round of collective bargaining that is expected to be negotiated between the Government of Canada and National Police Federation (NPF) on behalf of RCMP members.

While our municipality supports the RCMP's right upheld by the Supreme Court of Canada to collective bargaining and appreciates the service of RCMP officers in helping to protect our communities, any significant cost increases arising from the third round of collective bargaining would be detrimental to our municipality. During the first round of collective bargaining, the federal government negotiated a 23.7% retroactive pay increase which severely and negatively impacted municipal contract partners since we are the only order of government that must annually balance its books and not legally allowed to run a deficit. Similarly, the second round of collective bargaining resulted in further pay increases along with a surprise \$2,500 bonus for frontline officers, for which there was no advanced warning provided by the federal government; this bonus should have in no way whatsoever been billed to municipal contract partners. The fiscal shock caused by these decisions, often made without meaningful consultation or consideration of our financial reality, not only threatens the viability of our municipality but also undermines service delivery.

In addition, the questionnaire aimed at informing bargaining priorities that was recently developed by the Treasury Board Secretariat and distributed to our municipality represented a missed opportunity to meaningful engage with municipalities. We were disappointed to learn that our Municipal Associate Members on the Contract Management Commitment (CMC) were not consulted about the questionnaire's content before it was sent out. Moreover, since negotiations are conducted exclusively between the federal government and NPF, municipalities have little to no say in the collective bargaining process, despite being a paying contract partner responsible for 70% or 90% of total costs under the MPSA contract.

As updates from the federal government are often irregular and do not include any detailed information to municipalities during the negotiation process, our municipality therefore strongly urges the federal government to instruct its Chief Negotiator to advocate for **all** municipal contract partners and negotiate a deal that truly takes into account our fiscal circumstances, not just those of the general state of the Canadian economy or the federal government. We would also like to see a long-term deal negotiated to provide greater certainty and better align with our budgeting processes. These considerations are critical for respecting those on the ground responding to and managing the repercussions of decisions by the federal government while we balance our budgets and deliver essential services to our residents.
