### Pre-Authorization Plan (PAP) for Utility Bills

Quarterly water bill payments, automatically withdrawn, equal to the balance due on your quarterly utility invoice. Deadline to sign up is two weeks prior to the next due date.

### Online Utility Bill Services

Receive your quarterly water bill by email and view your statement online.

### Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP)

Monthly property tax payments or a single annual payment, automatically withdrawn for your convenience. Sign up at any time. To divide your payments over 12 months, sign up by mid-December 2024 for the 2025 tax year.

- Road, sewer and water main renewal - Hanover Street from 50m East of Reimer Avenue to 100m East.
- Water main renewal - Penner Street from Barkman Avenue to Reimer Avenue.
- Catch basin repairs - Brandt Street/PTH 12 North from Reimer Avenue to Elmdale Street

Please also exercise caution when passing city employees completing line painting, asphalt patching, watering plants and trees, or other roadside duties this season. Thank you for respecting pylons and other safety signs set up for their protection.
